

> **Cookies Policy**

At **Almirante Servicios Integrales** we comply with the provisions of the Information Society Services Law, a regulation that has transposed Directive 2009/136/EC.

What is a cookie?

A cookie is a small text file that is stored in your computer, tablet, cell phone or in short, in the device you use to browse the Internet, and can store information about how often you visit web pages, your browsing preferences, the information that most interests you, user names, register products, etc... Depending on the information they contain and the way you use your computer, they can be used to recognize the user.

Types of cookies

Depending on their nature, cookies can be classified into:

"Session Cookies" or "Persistent Cookies": the former are deleted when you close your browser, while the latter remain on your computer equipment.

"Own Cookies" or "Third-party Cookies": depending on whether they belong to the owner of the website itself, or to a third party.

According to their purpose they can be:

"Technical Cookies: These are those that allow the user to navigate through a website, platform or application and the use of different options or services it exist as, for example, control traffic and data communication, identify the session, access parts of restricted access, remember the elements of an order, make the buying process an order, make the application for registration or participation in an event, use security features while browsing, store content for broadcast video or sound or share content via social networks.

"Personalization Cookies": These are those that allow the user to access the service with some general characteristics predefined according to a series of criteria in the user's terminal such as the language, the type of browser through which you access the service, the regional settings from where you access the service, etc..

"Analysis cookies": These cookies allow the party responsible for them to monitor and analyze the behavior of the users of the websites to which they are linked. The information collected through this type of cookies is used to measure the activity of the websites, application or platform and for the elaboration of browsing profiles of the users of these sites, applications and platforms, in order to introduce improvements based on the analysis of the usage data of the users of the service.

"Advertising cookies": are those that allow the management, in the most effective way possible, of the advertising spaces that, where appropriate, the editor has included on a website, application or platform from which it provides the requested service based on criteria such as the edited content or the frequency at which the ads are displayed.

"Behavioral advertising cookies": are those that allow the management, in the most effective way possible, of the advertising spaces that, where appropriate, the publisher has included on a web page, application or platform from which it provides the requested service. These cookies store information on user behavior obtained through the continuous observation of their browsing habits, which allows the development of a specific profile to display advertising based on the same.
